Here's what you need to know:**

Neutral Ground is an artist-run centre that presents contemporary visual and media art. Located on Treaty 4 Territory/Regina, we connect audiences to the work of emerging and mid-career artists primarily from Saskatchewan and Canada. Launched in 1982, Neutral Ground serves a wide community that includes our members, artists, arts communities in Regina and beyond, and broader publics.

**Neutral Ground's mission is to:**

- Provide a professional venue for exhibitions and presentations;
- Facilitate meaningful experiences with art;
- Engage our audiences in critical dialogues.

**The Purpose and Role of the Board of Directors is to:**

- Govern and guide the Organization while supporting the Programming Director and Administrative Director in overseeing the Organization;
- Oversee the Organization's financial health, programs, and overall performance;
- Support the Programming and Administrative Directors in securing and appropriately managing resources to meet the needs of those the Organization serves.

**Individual Board Members are Responsible to:**

- Attend monthly Board meetings and other committee meetings as required;
- Attend Board meetings prepared and informed about issues on the agenda;
- Assume board leadership roles when asked or necessary;
- Serve the required term of office of a minimum of two years;
- Be prepared to devote 10-12 hours per month to the success of the Organization;
- Become knowledgeable about Neutral Ground's role in the contemporary arts and artist-run centre communities, being attuned to the social, political, and cultural factors affecting the Organization;
- Become knowledgeable about Board governance including policy, finance, programs, human resources, fundraising, and community relations
- Contribute to defining the Organization's strategic directions and approve of its strategic plan;
- Support staff and support the Organization's programming and exhibition initiatives;
- Lead in fundraising initiatives, through event planning and other funding opportunities;
- Support the Organization by attending Neutral Ground's public programming and events;
- Review Organization's bylaws, and recommend bylaw changes to the membership;
- Participate in the Annual General Meeting and other meetings of the membership;
- Build collegial working relationships with fellow Board Directors that contribute to consensus;
- Review Board and self-reflect on own performance periodically;
- Represent Neutral Ground's mission and vision in the community;
